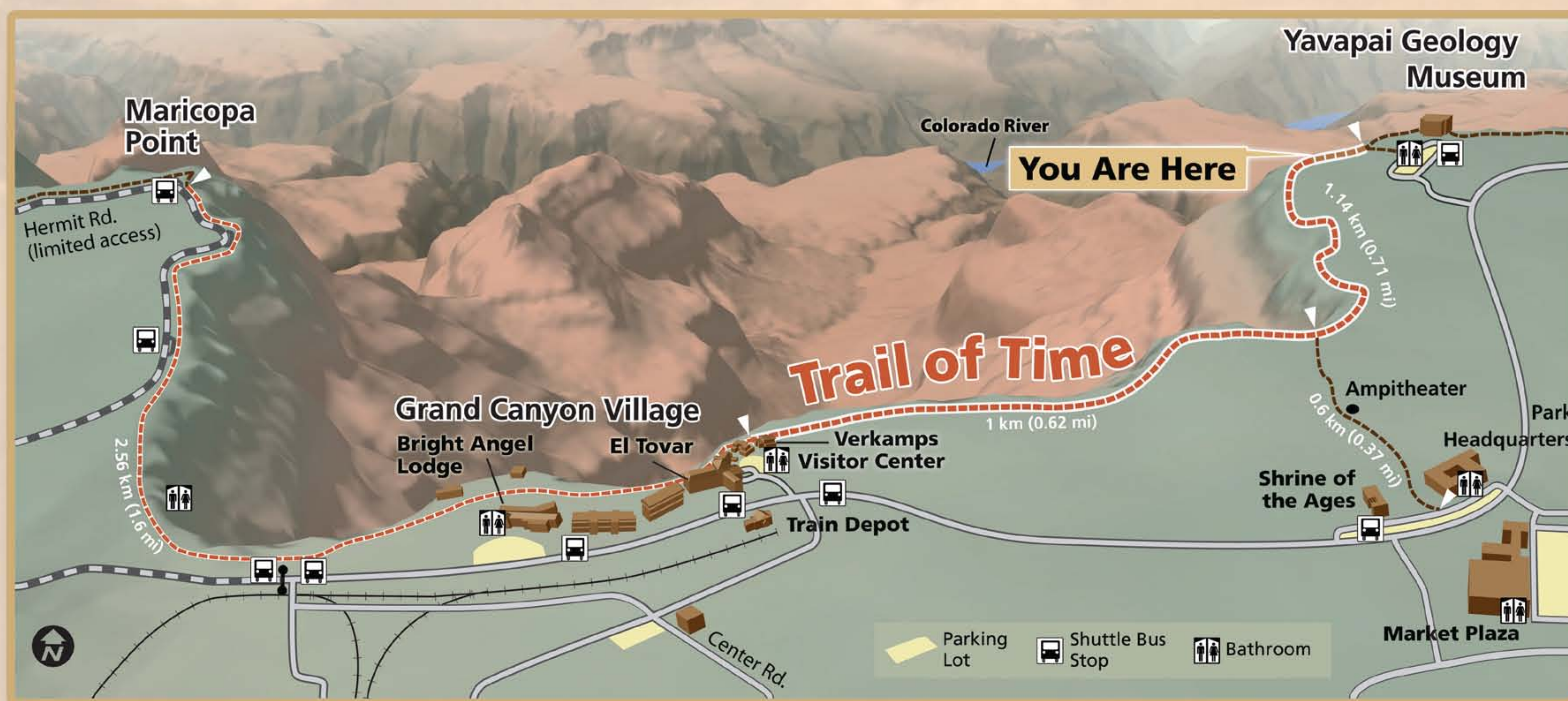

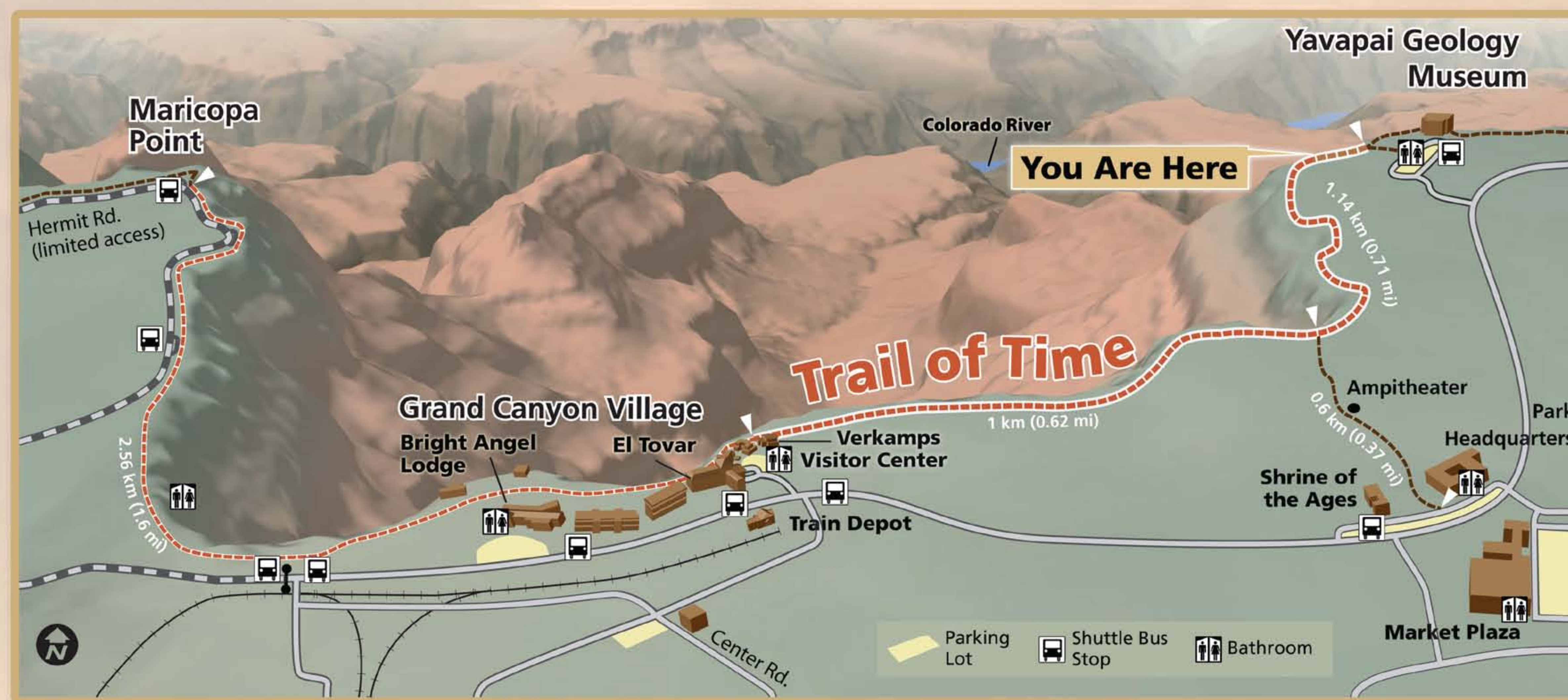
Congratulations! You have just walked a million years.

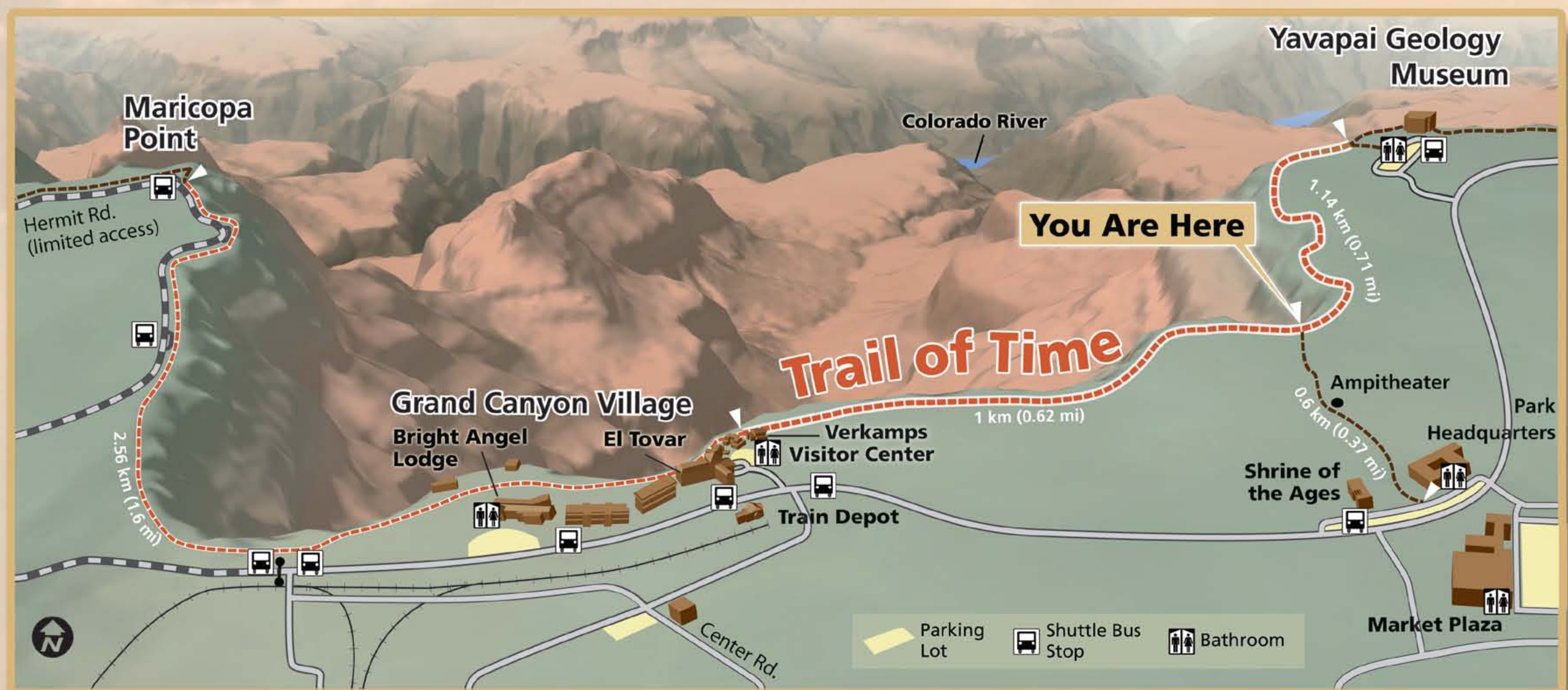
← Go left to see

Continue through the Village to Maricopa Point (2.5 km, 1.5 mi.) to the age of the Earth.



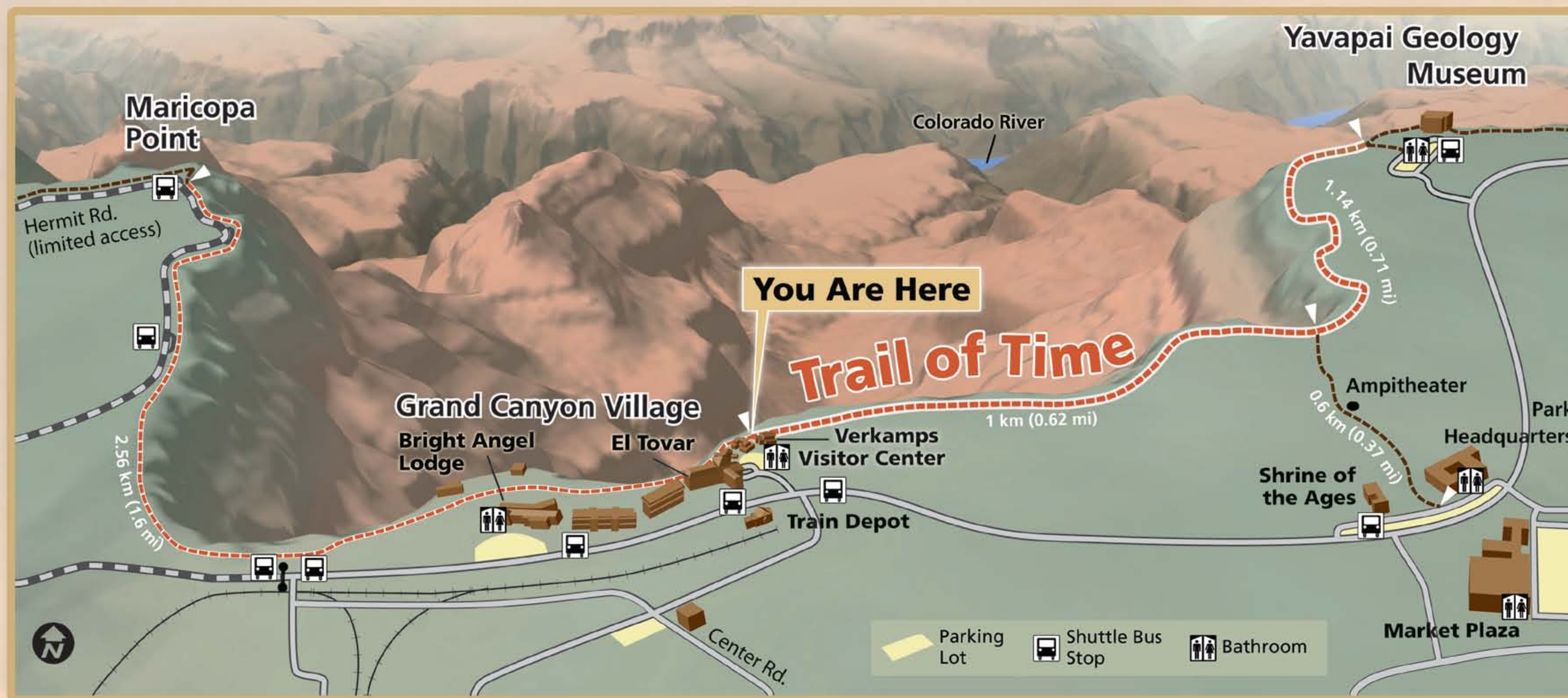
